Our parks are designed to blend in with the surroundings, featuring wildlife-friendly landscapes and fostering relationships with the community. We offer a range of B Corp-certified products from local suppliers in our park shop, including Tarquin's Gin, Cornish Ketchup, and Kittows meats. We also have a collection stand for used toiletry packaging, which we repurpose creatively with a local company called MYGroup.

We provide free amenities for our canine campers, such as biscuits, fresh water, and eco-friendly dog bags, and we have a Big 5 nature trail for kids. We offer wooden belly boards and beach clean sets to borrow, and we support local sanctuaries like the Cornish Birds of Prey Centre and the Cornish Seal Sanctuary.

We're proud of our B Corp certification and would love for you to join us in our efforts to protect the environment.

The South West Coast Path	Porth Beach, Newquay, TR7 3LU	The South West Coast Path passes through Mawgan Porth, offering miles of spectacular walks. Dogs are allowed on the path, but be mindful of the cliffs and keep your furry friend on a lead. 5 minutes drive from park.
Trenance Gardens	82 Edgcumbe Ave, Newquay TR7 2NW	Trenance Gardens is a lovely park with a lake, woodland walks, and a cafe. Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a lead in certain areas. 15 minutes drive from park.

Mawgan Porth Beach	Porth Beach, Newquay, TR7 3LU.	A 15 minute walk through woodland from our park takes you to Mawgan Porth beach, a beautiful cove made up of pristine sandy shores, crystal clear waters and towering cliffs. It's the perfect dog friendly spot to soak up the sun, build sandcastles, and hunt for hidden treasures. 5 minutes drive from park.
Bedruthan Steps	Carnewas at Bedruthan PL27 7UW	Head along the South West Coast Path to the National Trust's Bedruthan Steps for one of Cornwall's finest views. 5 minutes drive from park.
Mawgan Porth to St. Mawgan	Porth Beach, Newquay, TR7 3LU	The route winds through woods and hills, offering panoramic views. The trail then descends into a valley of wildflowers and farms, passing through small hamlets. The final stretch goes through shaded woodland and the picturesque village of St Mawgan, ending at the village green. 5 minutes drive from park.

Fistral Beach Newquay	TR7 IHY	This laidback and pet friendly beach is renowned for its mesmerising waves, making it an absolutely idyllic surf spot for surf enthusiasts and families alike. With its pristine shores and welcoming atmosphere, this beach stands out as a true haven for those seeking a perfect blend of relaxation and adventure. 20 minutes drive from park.
Harlyn Bay Beach	Padstow, PL28 8SQ	Harlyn Bay is a top spot for families and surfing newbies in Cornwall. With its lovely yellow sand, pebbles, and rock pools, it's the perfect pet friendly beach to relax and learn to catch some waves. Plus, there's plenty of room for everyone to spread out on the wide beach and enjoy the beautiful dunes. 20 minutes drive from park.
Watergate Bay	Watergate Bay, TR8 4AB	Golden sand stretches for two miles towards Newquay, where enormous Atlantic waves provide a spectacular sight and a popular destination for surfing and kitesurfing as well as pet friendly days out. Also, home to the Boardmasters Festival. 10 minutes drive from park.
Crantock Beach	Newquay, TR8 5RN	Crantock's pet friendly sandy beach is located just a short distance away from Newquay. Explore the dunes on Rushy Green and follow the banks of the Gannel Estuary. 25 minutes drive from park.

St Ives Food Festival 12th — 14th May	Porthminster Beach, St Ives, TR26 2EB	The St Ives Food and Drink Festival, held on Porthminster Beach over 3 days, offers top-notch cuisine, local drinks, and family-friendly entertainment. 1 hours drive from park.
Royal Cornwall Show 8th — 10th June	The Royal Cornwall Showground, Whitecross PL27 7JE	The Royal Cornwall Show showcases the best of Cornish countryside and coastline, with food stalls, music, dance, equestrian displays, and prize-winning animals such as cows, sheep, pigs, and horses. 20 minutes drive from park.
Rock Oyster Festival 27th — 30th July	Dinham House, Wadebridge, PL27 6RH	Let your taste buds dance with joy as you indulge in the festival's renowned Oyster Bar, showcasing the freshest and tastiest oysters from Cornish waters. 25 minutes drive from park.
Boardmasters 9th — 3rd August	Fistral Beach Newquay TR7 IHY	Taking place across Watergate Bay and Fistral Beach, this is a great festival for music and surf lovers. 10 minutes drive from park.

The National Lobster Hatchery	S Quay, PL28 8BL	The National Lobster Hatchery is a charity dedicated to marine conservation, research, and education. It's a great place for families to learn about the unique role of lobsters in our ecosystem. 20 minutes drive from park.
The Eden Project	Bodelva, PL24 2SG	The Eden Project's experimental gardens feature indoor biomes for visitors to explore, housing plant species from various parts of the globe. 30 minutes drive from park.
